Off the back of a truck...

ike all good success stories, Skaüswood starts off from the back of a van. But not just any old van. This van is called Holly. Holly is a Teal Blue '97 LDV Convoy 400. After 20 years as a school bus at an all girls school (named Holly Lodge) in Liverpool, Rob bought Holly and the next chapter of her life began. After 6 months of hard work she was finally transformed from a bus full of hidden chewing gum into a cosy camper-van, somewhat resembling a Swiss chalet, which Rob would go on to call his home for the next 5 years.

In early 2019, using skills gained during his formal architectural training and years of practice, Rob started designing and selling intricate, wooden artwork. He made these using the laser cutters of a community maker space in Liverpool Called DOES Liverpool. He dabbled in bits of jewellery at this time but the majority of his focus was on making artwork, exploring the nuances of colour theory and honing his skills with Birchwood. This change of direction was only possible thanks to the reduced overheads of living in a van.

Rob's ambition since finishing the conversion was always to travel but he knew this would require putting his design work on hold. However, in January 2020, just two weeks before embarking on a ferry to Amsterdam, he made a pivotal decision. After extensive research and calculations, he acquired his very first laser cutter (this would later be named 'Baby Bear'), it cost £300.00 and was a Chinese made K40. It was compact yet powerful enough to cut through 3mm Birchwood up to the size of an A4 sheet.

After spending a week visiting friends in Amsterdam, Rob installed Holly's first set of solar panels on the outskirts of town, consisting of 2 x 100W Polycrystalline rigid Solar Panels. He anxiously awaited the moment of truth - could he truly power a laser cutter using only solar panels and a battery? The exhilaration he felt when everything fired up and his calculations proved correct was unforgettable. His dream became a reality.

France went into lockdown & Holly didn't move for 10 weeks.

Their journey took them to Brussels and eventually to the French Alps, however their plans were abruptly halted when President Macron announced a nationwide lock-down with immediate effect due to COVID-19. Rob and Holly remained stationary for 10 weeks, giving Rob the opportunity to put his mobile art studio to the test. During this period, he designed a new range of earrings and pendants inspired by his natural surroundings, he named this range "Adventures Before Tea" (page 18).

Once the lock-down was lifted, Rob and Holly resumed their journey, heading south towards Ailefroide, a charming village and renowned rock-climbing destination in the Dauphiné Alps.

While in Briançon, with dwindling funds, Rob happened into a jewellery shop, known as Mano à Mano in the old town. After striking up a conversation with the owners, they agreed to purchase 15 pairs of earrings to test the waters. To Rob's, a mere seven days later, they called him back with excitement: "Hey man, we need more stock, we've sold everything!"

Returning to the shop, they took 75 pairs this time. Rob was elated and set off with Holly down the beautiful Vallee de La Claree and found a peaceful park up where he set up his studio and began designing earrings. He didn't expect to hear from the shop again, so was genuinely shocked 3 weeks later to receive a call asking for more jewellery. This was the turning point when he realised the immense potential in selling his jewellery wholesale to retailers. This marked his first venture into B2B operations.

From then till now Skaüswood has continued to flourish and takes pride in being a contemporary, responsible and design-driven accessory brand.

Today, Skaüswood operates from a spacious studio in Liverpool, where they've graduated from the confines of a van. Their original laser cutter is now accompanied by two larger machines, affectionately known as Mama Bear and Papa Bear. Despite these upgrades, one thing remains constant - all of their laser cutters are powered entirely by solar energy.







Our Returns Scheme

We know it can sometimes take a while for pieces to find their rightful owner, and in the meantime they can be hanging around your space.

We also know you may like the look of something but can't be sure that your customers will feel the same way.

To help with this in 2024 we will be introducing our **'Returns Scheme'** where by our partners will be able to return a selection of there existing Skaüswood stock with each new order placed **(up to a maximum value of 10% of the new order).**

Example:

- You place a new order worth £450.00
- Value of returned items should be no more than £45.00.



How it works

• place a new order on our website and notify us via email that you would like to action a return. Provide us with a list of the returning items along with the original invoice. Once we receive and verify this we will confirm the value of the items. (we will use the original prices you paid to value the items).

• The returned items should reach our workshop within a maximum of 7 working days.

• Once we receive your parcel we will carefully check over each item individually. Once completed we will issue you with a credit note to the value of the corresponding goods returned and the invoice for your new order. The total amount you will pay will be the difference between them.

All returning transactions must be as part of a new order.

We do not accept individual exchanges or returns.

We request you notify us about a return ASAP when placing a new order. We will need original invoice and invoice number in order to process a return.
